He was born in Hanoi, Vietnam. Nguyen Tai Hung received bachelor's and master's degrees in accordion from the Moscow Gnessin State Musical College (1983-1988) under Vladimir Motov and Gnessin Russian Academy of Music (1988-1993) under People's artist of Russia, professor Yury Dranga. Here, he also completed the course of conducting orchestra (class of People's artist of Russia & of Ukraine Vladimir Kozhukhar). In 2007, he successfully defended his doctoral dissertation on the accordion transcription.

Students in class of professor Nguyen Tai Hung have realized remarkable results in international music competitions in Switzerland, France, Portugal, Italy, Serbia, Latvia. For his contributions to music education, he was honored to receive certificates of merit from the Minister of Education and the Minister of Culture of Vietnam.

He has been a jury member of many prestigious international competitions, including the World Accordion Trophy "Trophée Mondial" (CMA), International Accordion Prize of Castelfidardo (PIF), World Accordion Contest "Italia Award" and other competitions in Serbia, Italy, France, Portugal, Latvia, Ukraine, Switzerland.
